## **Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2024 open the registration!**

**Applications for event participants will be sequentially opened for each runner category, starting from April 26th.**

The Tokyo Marathon Foundation aims to contribute to people's health and the building of a prosperous urban environment through the popularization of the sport of running. Leveraging the opportunity of Tokyo 2020 to pass on the legacy of the growing interest in sports and wellness to future generations, the foundation has established the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon. This year, it will be held for the third time on Sunday, October 20, 2024.

We have launched today an official website to provide information on the race information. (<https://legacyhalf.tokyo/en/index.html>). Acceptance of donations as well as charity runner entry will begin Friday, April 26, Thursday, May 2 for ONE TOKYO Premium members, and Wednesday, May 22 for Tokyo residents and general participants. \*Each entry includes para athletes and wheelchair athletes.

This half marathon (21.0975 km) will start and finish at the Japan National Stadium and utilize the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games marathon course. This race is designed to give everyone, beginner runners and athletes with and without disabilities, the extraordinary experience of running on a course usually reserved for professional races. We will also ask for a donation of 500 yen at the time of application to support victims of The 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake. The donations received will be donated to the Japanese Red Cross Society.

Our goal is to create an inclusive society by promoting charitable works through sports, revitalizing sports opportunities for people with disabilities, and providing ongoing training and support for volunteers engaged in these activities.

The Tokyo Marathon Foundation Charity "RUN with HEART" will conduct charity activities at the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2024, scheduled on Sunday, October 20, 2024. We are looking for charity runners who can work with us to think about how we can promote sports, and support environmental conservation, refugees, sick children and animal welfare, among others, through the half marathon and other events, as well as share our initiatives with the world.

Details regarding the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2024 Charity are provided below.

#### **■Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2024 Charity Outline**

##### **1. 24 recipient programs (organizations) conducting the charity program**

24 recipient organizations are set to participate in undertakings that promote sports and support environmental conservation, refugees, sick and impoverished children and animal welfare.

##### **2. How to participate the charity**

There are two ways to participate.

- 1) Donate 50,000 yen or more and be a charity runner.
- 2) Donation only: 1,000 yen or more (from minimum amount set by each recipient organizations)

#### 4. Examples from the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2023 Charity (Tokyo Marathon Foundation Sports Legacy Program)

Last year, a para-athletics class was held in the Japan National Stadium in conjunction with the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2023 on the day of the race, Sunday, October 15. The class was designed for beginner athletics with disabilities from elementary school age and up. Three classes were held for each disability with each being led by an experienced coach and athlete.



#### Pride House Tokyo NPO

At the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon, we aim to run an LGBTQ+ friendly event. Pride House Tokyo, with which we have an agreement to promote diversity at sporting events, supported the tournament management from an LGBTQ+ perspective in guiding runners to gender-inclusive changing rooms inside the National Stadium, the start and finish venue, and providing advice on various productions. At the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2023, an 'LGBTQ+ Study Session' was held for participating runners and volunteers. Airi Murakami, an active rugby player and director of Pride House Tokyo Athletes' Transmission Team, served as a lecturer. She shared her basic knowledge of LGBTQ+ issues and her experiences as an LGBTQ+ athlete. Additionally, there was a discussion with guest speaker M Takashi.

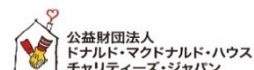
