

**Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2025 Charity**  
**Total donations reached 40,620,173 yen**  
**Thank you to everyone who supported and donated.**

Donations for the Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2025 Charity closed on Friday, May 23, 2025, and over 40 million yen were collected. Donations will be used for the Charity Programs selected by the donors to promote sports and support environmental conservation, refugees, sick and impoverished children, and animal welfare.

Through entries for Tokyo Legacy Half Marathon 2025, we collected 500 yen from each runner to help support recovery efforts for the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake, which struck on January 1, 2024. Collectively, the 6,873 runners raised 3,436,500 yen. Donations collected will be sent to the Donation Distribution Committee of the disaster-stricken areas via the Japanese Red Cross Society as disaster relief funds.
